c) Verification of other requirements, such as a mattress, textbooks, etc.

4. College Diet and Medical Care


- (a) The College provides a wholesome diet. No special diet will be provided in the college.

ANNEX 1: ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS MURANG'A TEACHERS' TRAINING COLLEGE

1. REGISTRATION DOCUMENTS

On admission day, you will be required to bring:-

- (i) The following documents are for verification.
 - a) Original National Identity Card
 - b) Letter of offer of admission.
 - c) Original and certified copy of K. C. S. E. Certificate/Results Slip
 - d) Original and certified copy of K.C.S.E School Leaving Certificate
 - e) Original and certified copy of Birth Certificate.
- (ii) One clear photocopy of:-
 - (a) National Identity Card
 - (b) **TWO** color passport-size photographs taken within the last three months, certified and stamped by your Chief or Assistant Chief.
- (iii) Other requirements, in the joining instructions/admission document
 - (a) Duly filled Student's Biodata form (Annex 2)
 - (b) Duly filled Medical Certificate (Annex 3)
 - (c) Duly signed Students' Declaration form (Annex 4)
- (iv) All documents apart from the originals shall be presented to the registering staff well filed in a "blue color" spring file.

NOTE

Ensure that your original National Identity card is returned to you after verification.

3. BOARDING REQUIREMENTS

- i) Buy a mattress 2¹/₂ ft by 4 inches thick in the College at a negotiated price of Ksh. 2,600/-.

- iii) A pair of black shoes (low heels).
